

LAHSER ROAD RECONSTRUCTION TO START IN JULY, CIVIC CENTER DRIVE TO 11 MILE ROAD

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the City of Southfield, will reconstruct Lahser Road from Civic Center Drive to Northwestern Highway (M-10) and will perform concrete repair work from Northwestern Highway to 11 Mile Road.

Schedule: The work is expected to start in mid-July and be completed by mid-September.

PROJECT DETAILS

Between Civic Center Dr. and Northwestern Highway, the existing concrete road will be removed and replaced with a new concrete roadway. Between Northwestern Highway and 11 Mile Road, only deteriorated concrete slabs will be replaced.

The project will include some isolated pedestrian sidewalk ramp replacements and traffic signal adjustments. Minor drainage improvements will also be made.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

During the project, Lahser Road will be completely closed to all traffic between Civic Center Drive and the eastbound Northwestern Highway service drive. All properties along this section of Lahser will be accessed from the eastbound Northwestern Highway service drive or from Civic Center Drive.

The detour route for through traffic is the Northwestern Highway service drive eastbound to Civic Center Drive and back to Lahser and vice versa.

Pedestrians will also be prohibited from traveling through the construction area. The pedestrian detour

route will be the eastbound Northwestern Highway service drive west of Lahser to First Center Drive to Civic Center Drive and vice versa.

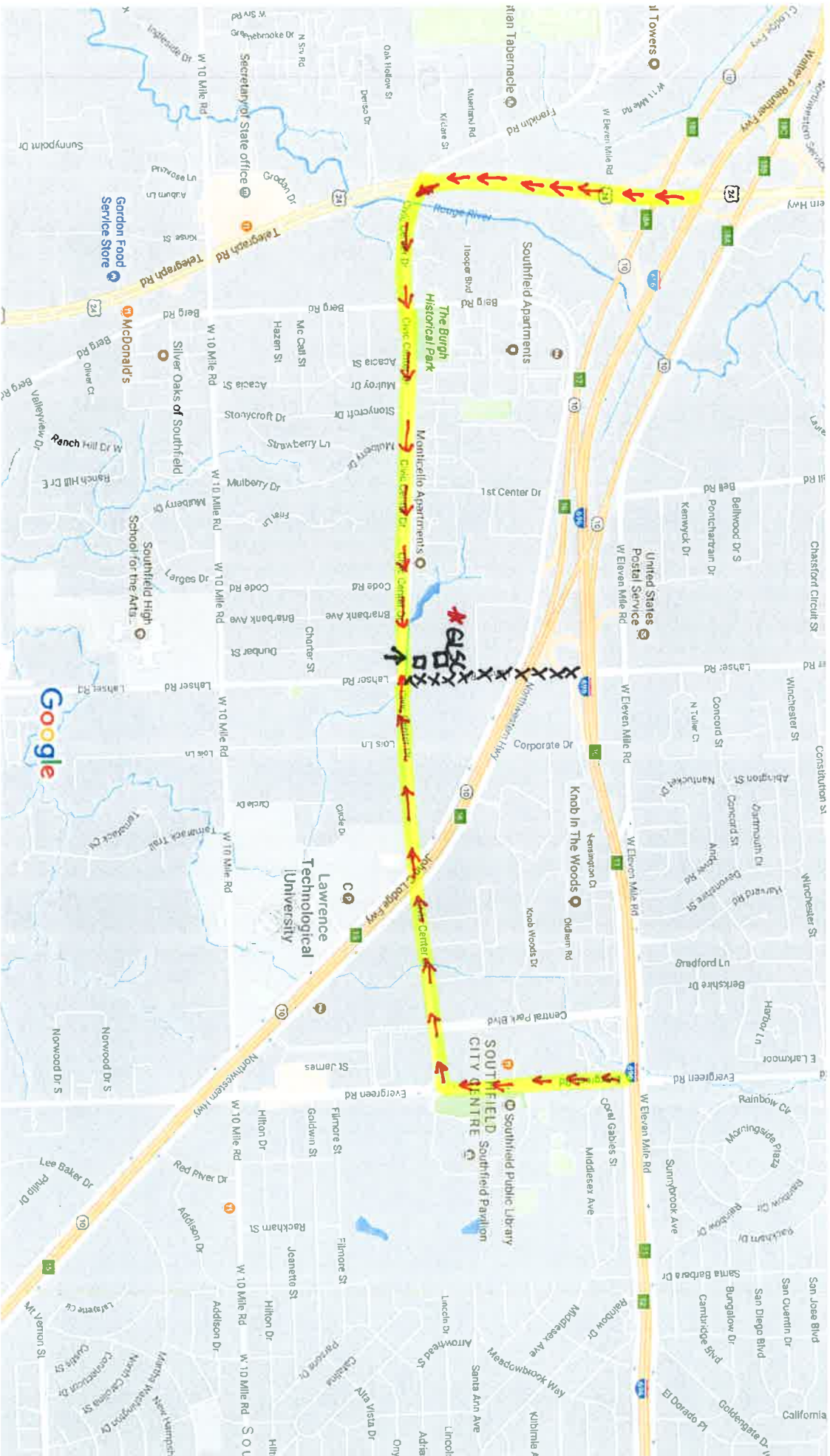
Lahser Road between the eastbound Northwestern Highway service drive and 11 Mile road will be reduced to one lane in each direction for approximately four weeks. During some stages of the work, there will be closures of the on ramps to eastbound I-696/Coral Gables Street as well as the northbound M-10 off ramp to Lahser Road. During those short closures, detours will be posted.

PROJECT COST & FUNDING

The project is expected to cost \$2 million. The cost will be split between RCOC, the City of Southfield and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).

Great Lakes Surgical Center (GLSC) is located at 26051 Lahser Road. Lahser Road is closed for construction.

If you will be accessing GLSC via 696 or from the North you will need to use an alternative route.

From the East (696 Westbound) – Exit 696 at Evergreen Road. Take Evergreen South to Civic Center Drive. Turn Right (West) onto Civic Center Drive. After passing Lahser Rd the entrance will be immediately on your Right (North). You must enter through Michigan Orthopaedic Institute's parking lot.

From the West (696 Eastbound) – Exit 696 at Telegraph (M-24) Road. Take Telegraph South to Civic Center Drive. Make a legal U-turn (Michigan Left) at Civic Center Drive. Turn Right and head East on Civic Center Drive. You will enter through Michigan Orthopaedic Institute's parking lot on the Left (North). If you get to Lahser Road, you've gone too far.
